Overview of Year

A positive year with the re-start of the MACP Podcast series, successful focussed symposium, skills workshop and networking sessions broadening the scope of rehabilitation at CSP Conference 2024. Successful networking with potential international opportunities for growth of MACP membership.

Progress against organisation's strategic aims

- 1. To grow brand awareness of the MACP organization through membership activity
- The role of knowledge translation, mobilisation, and transformation within the MACP continues to evolve. The MACP have again been successful in having a focussed symposium, a skills session and networking session accepted at the CSP conference 2024.
- There was active involvement of the MACP executive committee at IFOMPT 2024 in Basel with chairing, presentations and networking to facilitate knowledge exchange. - Continue to create MACP podcast series on interesting, remarkable and important topics related to MSK Physiotherapy.
- Develop a Critical MSK Physiotherapy Series.
