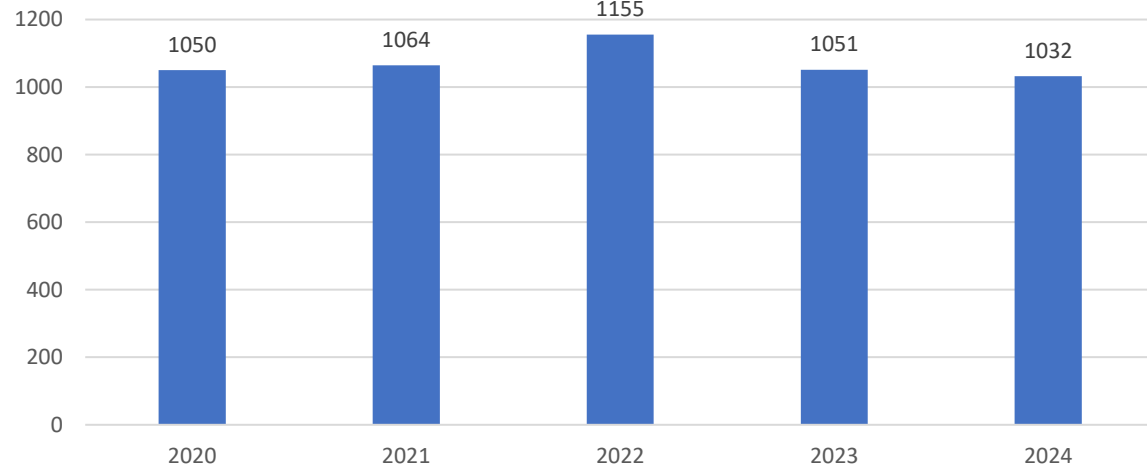

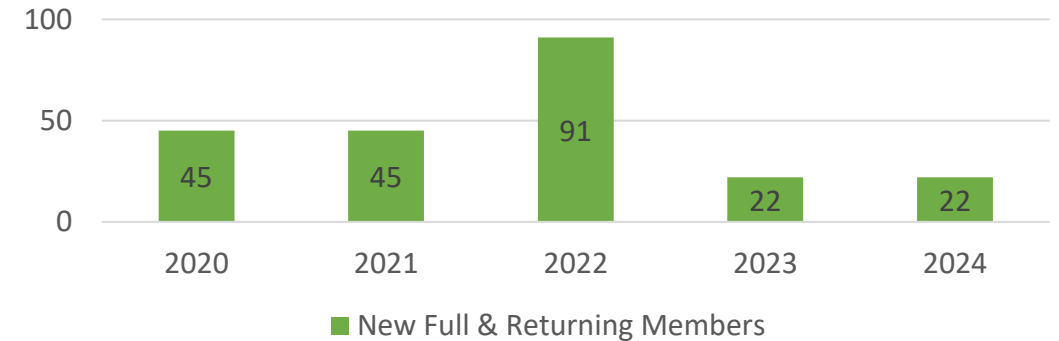

Full Membership of MACP



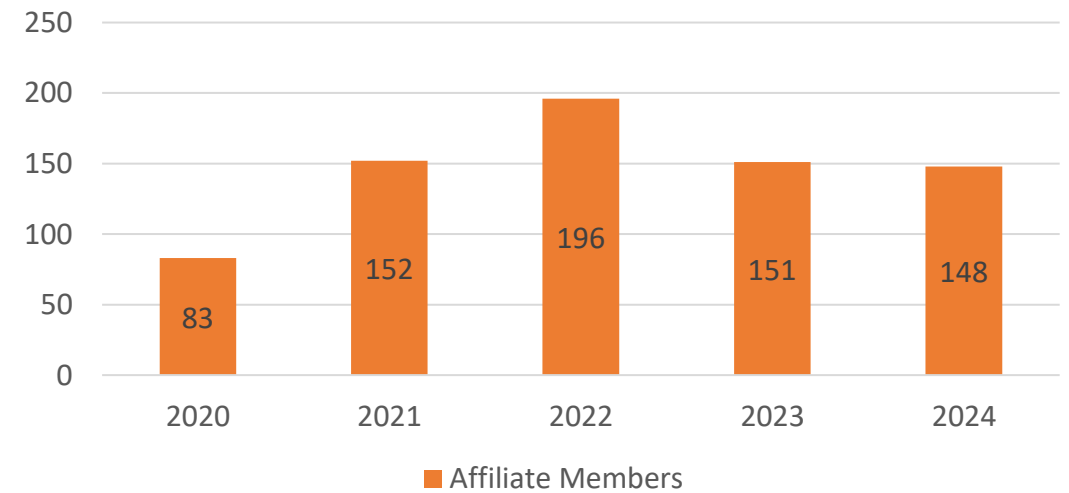

The use of minimising language in musculoskeletal consultations
Professor Lisa Roberts.

Despite the fact that communication impacts upon every healthcare interaction and is responsible for the largest number of complaints in NHS hospital and community health services across England, research using observational, real-time data is lacking, and the empirical evidence base is limited. This study will generate new knowledge about communication, specifically identifying the prevalence and impact of physiotherapists' use of minimising language (phrases such as 'just', 'quick', 'only', 'a little' etc.), which have not been reported in musculoskeletal interactions to date.
