



General Guidelines

MACP Level 2 & 3 Research Awards

1. Background information

The MACP research committee aims to support research in the field of neuromusculoskeletal physiotherapy and promote research-related activities.

2. Criteria for applications

- 2.1. Applications will be considered from physiotherapists who are full members of the MACP
- 2.2. Applications should be for one (or more) of the activities below:
 - 2.2.1. Courses that support research
 - 2.2.2. Travel and accommodation to support access to conferences or courses that support research.
 - 2.2.3. Expenditure for the development and undertaking of research.
 - 2.2.4. Presentation/publication costs.
 - 2.2.5. Disseminating research to the general public.
- 2.3. Retrospective applications will not be considered.
- 2.4. Preference will be given to applications that address and support current research priorities.
- 2.5. Completion of a 1000-word (level 2) or 1500-word (level 3) supporting statement.

3. Judgment of applications

- 3.1. Applications will be judged by the MACP research committee.
- 3.2. Judgment will normally be conveyed in writing to the applicant within 6 weeks of the deadline.
- 3.3. The decision of the research committee will be final and no correspondence with the applicant will be entered into.
- 3.4. The awards will be announced at the MACPAGM, where the successful applicant (or A nominated representative) will be presented with the award.

4. Conditions of the award

- 4.1. Any publications, posters, or press releases that relate to work supported by the award should acknowledge the MACP.

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- 4.2. The successful applicant will be required to produce a 1000-word (Level 2) or 1500-word (Level 3) report, which will be uploaded to the MACP website and sent out on twitter, within 3 months of the end of the study period.
- 4.3. In addition, the candidate will be expected to produce the following outputs:
 - Level 2: A presentation and/or podcast¹ to MACP members.
 - Level 3: A presentation and/or podcast, OR abstract/poster/publication, AND provide evidence of mentorship (within a 12-month period) for other members wishing to apply for this award.
- 4.4. Any applicant not meeting this requirement will be required to reimburse the MACP for the full amount of the award.

5. Application procedure

- 5.1. The applicant must complete the MACP Level 2 & 3 Research Award application form.
- 5.2. A CV (not exceeding 2 sides of A4) should be submitted with the application form.
- 5.3. Within the breakdown of costs, please note that travel and accommodation expenses should be kept to a minimum (for example, second-class rail, standard mileage, and budget accommodation).
- 5.4. Applications must be submitted electronically to the chair of the CEPD committee at: admin@macpweb.org

6. Payment of monies

- 6.1. Monies will only be paid once confirmation of acceptance and attendance at the meeting/conference has been received.
